About Your Work Online

As an ITOP meeting participant you are being asked to participate online as well as face-to-face. An online conference has been created to support the work and planning processes you are involved with. The conference will provide you with ongoing opportunities to do your work at a distance regardless of the time of day.

Participating in the online conference is simple! Your work online will be guided through emails from Marin Brown, and online facilitators. The site is available to you 24 hrs a day seven days a week and you will find it easy to post your comments, share information, and access resources.

Week 1 (August 9-15) Introduce Yourself

Visit <http://www.improvingyouthtransitions.org> and click on the Conference Entry link. You will be prompted for your userid/password (this will be emailed to you). Follow the instructions on the screen to post your introduction and to read other introductions. Feel free to talk amongst yourselves here as well.

Week 2 (August 16-21) Computer Lab/WebQuest

In Sacramento a computer lab will be available to you. In the computer lab you will have another opportunity to post your introduction. In addition to this, you will be asked to complete a WebQuest. The WebQuest contains tasks to help orient you to the online conference center and the ITOP website.

Week 3 (August 22-28) Workgroups

Each workgroup will be assigned their own online conference. Each workgroup will then be charged with finalizing their meeting objectives and developing action plans within that space. An online facilitator will be assigned to each workgroup, and will help guide you in your work online.
